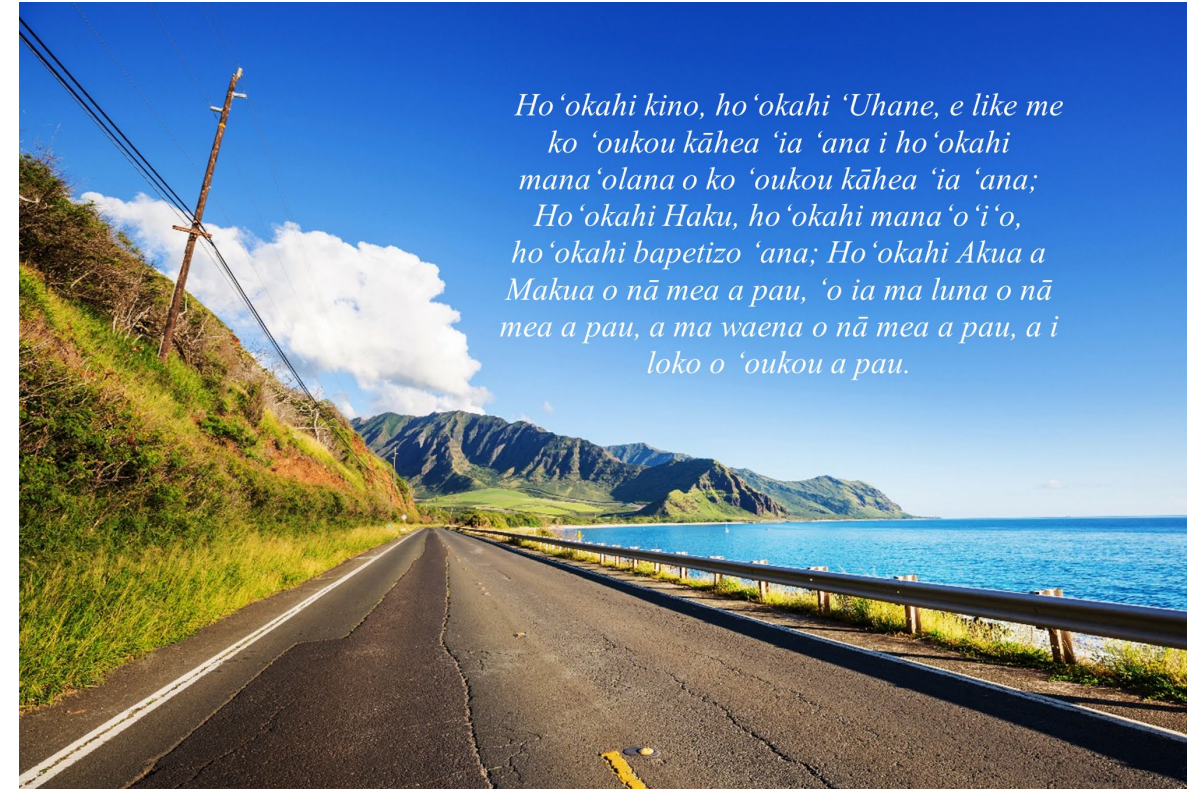

Registration: This registration packet and form are for the ‘Aha Nā Kai ‘Ewalu only. Separate registration packets for the ‘Aha Makua and State Council of Hawaiian Congregational Churches have been mailed.

All local church delegates and visitors attending the ‘Aha Nā Kai ‘Ewalu shall register as required.

- **All who attend must register by 4:00 pm, Monday, May 11, 2026.** One form for each registrant with payment (\$95 per person). Online registration will close at 4:00 pm on **Monday, May 11, 2026.**
- Walk-ins will be accepted on site at the ‘Aha Nā Kai ‘Ewalu.
- **Retired Pastors** who previously served our member Hawaiian churches will have their registration fees for the ‘Aha Nā Kai ‘Ewalu waived.

Meeting Information:

Business: Delegates are encouraged to familiarize themselves with information on the business items that will be discussed during the annual meetings.

Transportation and Housing:

Airlines: Delegates and visitors are responsible for their own flight reservations and payments.

Shuttles: Provided for all **NEIGHBOR ISLAND PARTICIPANTS** attending the ‘Aha Nā Kai ‘Ewalu and ‘Aha Makua.

Arrivals: Shuttles will be provided from Daniel K. Inouye International Airport to Ewa Community Church for participants who complete the transportation section of the registration form and submit it by **May 11, 2026.** Vans will meet only the flights for which pick-ups have been scheduled. If you decide you do not need a ride later, please contact Chris Nuuhiwa at 808-791-5649 so drivers are not kept waiting.

Continuous shuttles will **NOT** be available. Pick-up times will be arranged exclusively for those who provide arrival details on the registration form. Upon arrival, proceed to the curb outside the Hawaiian Airlines and Southwest baggage claim area. **Please be patient if the van has not yet arrived.**

Parking: Parking is available on the side and at the rear of Ewa Community Church.
