WILLIAM KAHUAKA‘I KELI‘IHO‘OMALU SCHOLARSHIP FUND

BACKGROUND

The Endowment Committee of the State Council of Hawaiian Congregational Churches (SCHCC) receives and processes all program grants and scholarship requests for the following:

1. *Kahu* Richard W. Wong Grant
2. Katherine & Clay Wery Grant
3. William Kahuaka‘i Keli‘iho‘omalua Scholarship Grant/Loan

All of the grants are provided through income that is generated through endowments that are held and managed by the Hawai‘i Conference Foundation (HCF).

This packet contains information and an initial application form and an application for a scholarship renewal form for the William Kahuaka‘i Keli‘iho‘omalua Scholarship Fund.

The William Kahuaka‘i Keli‘iho‘omalua Scholarship Fund was established following the passing of Licentiate *Kahu* William K. Keli‘iho‘omalua. *Kahu* Keli‘iho‘omalua served as a member deacon of Kawaiaha‘o Church for over 20 years.

Kahu enrolled in the Lay Pastors School on the island of Maui and received his certificate as a Licensed Minister of the ‘*Aha O Nā Mokupuni ‘O Maui, Molok‘i a me Lāna‘i* (Tri-Isle Association). *Kahu* served at the Pā‘ia Hawaiian Protestant Church for a number of years until his retirement.

He moved back to his home on the island of Hawai‘I in the village of Kalapana, Puna. Upon his death, this scholarship was established as a gift from Mrs. Ada Larrison, a friend of the family. She asked that this gift be placed in a custodial account with the Hawai‘i Conference Foundation in the name of the “William Kahuaka‘i Keli‘iho‘omalua Scholarship Fund.”

Over the years, family and friends and investments raised that fund to \$5,000. It was Mrs. Larrison’s request that the principle of \$5,000 remain in the account and that the interest income received would be used to provide scholarships.

The purpose of the scholarship fund is to provide financial support to cover the educational and continuing education needs of Members-In-Discernment (MID), Lay or Ordained Ministers. Applicant must be an active member in a SCHCC congregation.

Applicants must also be enrolled in an accredited theological school recognized by The Association of Theological Schools in North America or in a continuing education program that is certified.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND DESCRIPTION

Scholarships will be awarded for the following:

1. Seminary – 1 to 3 years
Not to exceed \$1,000 per year
2. Certification Programs -1-2 years
Not to exceed \$1,000 per year
3. Continuing Education – 1-3 years
Not to exceed \$1,000 per year

Scholarships approved for an accredited seminary will be sent to that seminary. Scholarships for organizations offering a certification program or a continuing education program will be sent to the applicant.

If the applicant does not complete his/her/their education, it is understood that the amount of the grant shall become a loan. **A promissory note will be signed by the applicant at the time that a scholarship is approved.**
